WINE PREPARATION

The rosé wines Les Voiles belong to AOP Bandol group, one of the oldest appellations in the Provence. The vineyards of appellation cover 8 villages around the town of Bandol. They are located in a vast amphitheater of mountains of the Sainte-Baume and Mont-Caume, surrounded by hills, generally on lime-sand

Cultivated in the area Mourvedre, Grenache and Cinsault varietals benefiting from whitish and very dry land, rich on silica elements. Yields in the region are low, maximum 40 hl / ha.
